In early June the plastering on the outside of the five classroom building was being completed. The classrooms are almost ready for use. In Zambia the government will have to declare that this school can be used for grades Pre-K thru 12. Since 2021 the school has served students Pre-K through grade 10.

There are 7 students who will graduate from schools in neighboring areas in December, ending Maanza a Leza's time for sponsoring students outside of Sichibeya. Our prayers are that future students will have a wonderful school experience and become high school graduates from their own village school. The villagers and Maanza a Leza should have God's dream of a finished facility realized soon.


Maanza a Leza's Ministry in the USA
